



2024 Soup & Solstice **Bowl and Mug Donation Guidelines**

Thank you so much for your interest in donating a bowl and/or mug to our fundraising bowl and mug sale at Feeding Laramie Valley's (FLV) Third Soup-Off! We are asking for donations of hand-crafted bowls and mugs for a fundraising sale at our Soup & Solstice Celebration on Wednesday, December 18, 2024 from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM. Donated bowls and mugs will be sold by Feeding Laramie Valley, with 100% of the profits going towards accomplishing FLV's mission of building equitable, just and sustainable food systems in Albany County, WY. In 2023, through the generous donations of the community we were able to raise over \$1300 for our Feeding Laramie Valley programs from our Soup & Solstice event! FLV has over 13 programs that contribute to accomplishing our mission such as; Shares bags, the Mobile Market, Community Gardens, and more. To give you a better idea of how your donation will help us, an example of how FLV could use the money:

- \$5 = 1 shares bag for 1 person
- \$10 = 1 shares bag for a couple
- \$20 = 1 shares bag for a family of 4
- \$50 = 10 weeks of shares bags for 1 person
- \$100 = 10 weeks of shares bags for a couple
- \$200 = 10 weeks of shares bags for a family of 4

Below are a few guidelines to help ensure that all donated bowls and mugs are safe for use. We welcome bowls and mugs made at all skill levels! Do you or your kids have a pottery hobby? We'd love to have your unique, original work as long as it meets the following criteria.

- Bowls/mugs can be made of a number of materials, including kiln-fired clay or wood.
- All bowls/mugs must be solid, meaning there cannot be any holes, chips, or cracks that might compromise the bowl or mug's structure or ability to hold soup.
- **Please list if the bowl/mug is dishwasher and/or microwave safe**
- We ask that donated bowls/mugs be designed without nooks or crevasses that could harbor bacteria the smoother the better.
- All bowls/mugs **must** be made with non-toxic & food-safe materials, especially if painted or glazed. If food safe paint is not available to you, please keep all painting on the outside of the bowl/mug only so that it won't come into contact with the food.

PLEASE NOTE: air-dry clay and any clay that is not fired in a kiln is not considered food safe.
